

# **Camping Molignon Rules and Regulations**

Camping Molignon is a place for relaxation and conviviality. To ensure a pleasant stay for all our campers, we ask you to respect these rules. By entering the campsite, you agree to abide by these rules.

## 1. Access and opening times

- Access to the campsite is open every day from 7am to 10pm. Outside these hours, please respect the silence and privacy of other campers.
- Reception is open seasonally, according to the opening hours displayed at reception.

# 2. Booking and payment

- Reservations are recommended, especially in high season. Reservations are confirmed on receipt of a deposit.
- The balance for rentals must be paid 40 days before arrival and for camping pitches the evening before departure.
- In the event of cancellation, please consult our cancellation policy on the website or at reception.

#### 3. Locations

- Pitches are allocated on arrival. It is not always possible to choose a specific pitch, but we will do our best to accommodate your request.
- **Pitches must be vacated by 11.00 am** on the day of departure, to allow the pitch to be prepared for new arrivals.
- **Pitches are available from 1pm** on the day of arrival. Please respect these times to ensure optimum organisation.

# 4. Rentals

- Rentals (mobile homes, bungalows, etc.) must be returned **before 9.30 am on** the day of departure.
- **Rentals are available from 4pm** on the day of arrival. Please respect these times to allow for adequate cleaning and preparation of the accommodation.

#### 5. Camper behaviour

- Respect, friendliness and tranquillity are essential. Noise is forbidden after 10 p.m. and before 8 a.m. (respect the hours of silence).
- Noisy parties, loud music and other noise pollution are prohibited at all times.
- Visitors must register at reception. Anyone not complying with the rules may be expelled without refund.

#### 6. Animals

- Pets are welcome provided they are kept on a lead at all times throughout the campsite.
- You are responsible for keeping your pet clean, so please pick up after it.
- 1st and 2nd category dogs are not allowed on the site.

# 7. Hygiene and cleanliness

- All campers are responsible for their pitch and must leave it clean when they leave. It is imperative not to leave anything on the pitch, in particular stones and other objects picked up during your walks.
- Rubbish bins and containers are available for selective sorting. Please respect these instructions.
- It is forbidden to burn rubbish or throw it on the ground.

# 8. Security

- Open fires are strictly prohibited, except in designated areas.
- Barbecues are permitted, subject to compliance with safety regulations.
- Campers must comply with safety and evacuation instructions in the event of fire or emergency.
- The use of generators is prohibited on campsites.

# 9. Vehicles and parking

- Vehicles must be parked in the spaces provided. It is forbidden to park a vehicle on the aisles of the campsite or on another pitch.
- Campers must respect the speed limits and traffic rules inside the campsite.

#### **10. Swimming pool**

- The swimming pool is open every day from **10am to 6pm**.
- The swimming pool **is not supervised**. Campers are responsible for their own access to the pool.
- **Parents must supervise their children at** all times when using the swimming pool. In the event of an accident, the campsite cannot be held responsible.
- It is forbidden to run, dive or engage in any activity that might disturb the peace and quiet of other campers in the pool area.
- Access to the swimming pool is reserved for campers and visitors who have paid for their stay.

# **11. Activities and facilities**

- The activities offered by the campsite (swimming pool, play areas, etc.) are available during the times indicated at reception.
- Campers must respect the rules for using the equipment and the associated safety instructions.

# 12. Liability

- Camping Molignon accepts no responsibility for the theft, loss or damage of personal items.
- We recommend that you take out insurance to cover the risks associated with your stay (accidents, civil liability, etc.).

## 13. Entry and residence rights

- The campsite reserves the right to refuse entry to or expel any camper who does not comply with these rules or who causes a nuisance.
- The campsite does not reimburse in the event of eviction for failure to comply with the rules.

#### 14. Changes to the regulations

• The rules may be amended according to the needs of the campsite or administrative directives. Any changes will be posted at reception.
